

Churn Dash Quilt Block Tutorial

10½" unfinished quilt block

Cutting Guide:

White fabric - cut (2) 4 7/8" squares

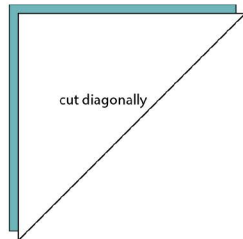
White fabric - cut (5) 2½" squares

Light batik - cut (2) 4 7/8" squares

Dark batik - cut (4) 2½" squares

Piecing the half square triangle (HST) blocks:

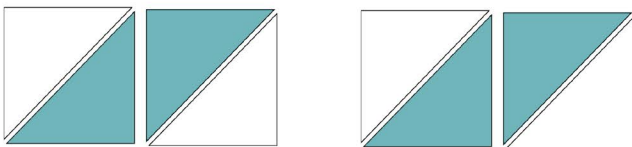
Place the white 4 7/8" square on top of the light batik 4 7/8" square - cut diagonally. Repeat this.



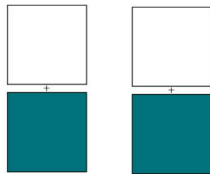
Use a scant 1/4" seam allowance

Sew the two pieces together, trim the dog-ears. Your half square triangles should measure 4½"

Make (4)



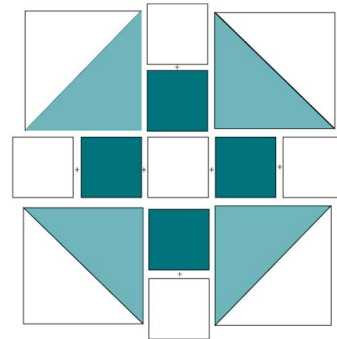
Sew the 2½" squares together as shown below.



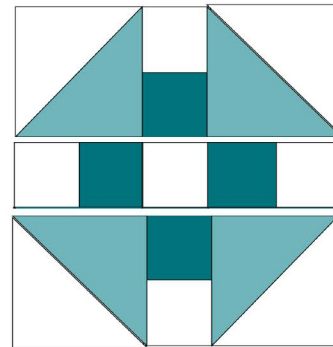
This is the middle row.



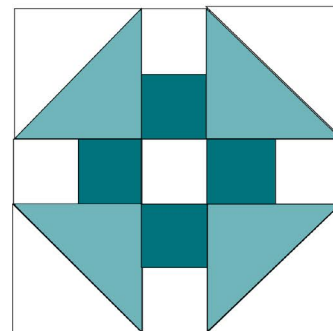
Layout your pieces and sew together.



Sew your rows together like this.



Finished 10½" quilt block

Light batik - cut (4) 2½" squares

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
